- 01 A hedge fund is a pooled investment that is pulled by a partnership of institutional or accredited investors like Banks, High Net worth individuals, Endowments & Pension Funds



WHAT IS HEDGE FUND?

02 Investment in a Hedge fund is usually requires a high minimum investment or, say, net worth, often targeting affluent and rich clients.

HiSTORY

Modern hedge fund history began with Alfred Winslow Jones, a sociologist and journalist who wrote about market behavior in the 1930s and 1940s and founded one of the first hedge funds in 1949.



ROI

The average annual return on investment for hedge funds varies widely depending on the fund's strategy, market conditions, and the skill of the fund managers



RELATED DEFINITIONS

RELATIVE VALUE FUNDS

A type of hedge fund that uses leverage to increase returns. They take long positions on securities they think are undervalued, and short positions on related securities they think are overvalued.

ALPHA

A term that represents an asset manager's skill compared to market performance.

BETA

A concept that shows the relationship between a hedge fund's returns and the market return. It can also show how much risk the fund is taking on in certain asset classes.

RELATED DEFINITIONS

DUE DILIGENCE

An important step in the investment process, due diligence involves assessing whether a potential investment fits with the portfolio's overall objectives.

FEES

Hedge funds charge fees to cover the costs of managing the fund and to compensate the fund manager. These fees can include a management fee and a performance fee.

INVESTORS

Investors in a hedge fund are typically accredited investors, which means they meet a minimum level of income or assets.



ESSENCE

Investors' primary purpose is to make a profit, and market risk and volatility are inherent in the market.

Hedging allows traders and investors to reduce market risk and volatility. It reduces the probability of losing.




DAVID TEPPER


RAY DALIO
